Bonn is an international city at heart – a veritable melting pot that is home to numerous foreign companies, global institutions and a rising number of local businesses with an international character. So in many cases, it's for professional reasons that new arrivals from near and far settle here in the Federal City, as Bonn is also known.

Starting a new job abroad is a small adventure in itself for foreign professionals. What makes this stage of life even more challenging is having to navigate an entirely new home country and establish a daily routine for themselves and their families. The information in this brochure is intended to assist new residents in managing a short- or long-term stay in Bonn and the surrounding Rhine-Sieg district.

Even prior to arrival, it will often be necessary to research various topics, such as the character of and amenities offered by the city and the surrounding area, notably its educational institutions. One way this can be done is to draw on the experience of expats already living locally who are active in relevant social networks. Furthermore, local relocation services provide a comprehensive range of information and resources to assist new residents as they prepare to move here from abroad.

Upon arrival in Bonn, there are numerous ways to strike up personal relationships with like-minded individuals and families. International clubs and country associations organise regular social events and often also discussion groups (held in German or a foreign language). Bonn is also home to a number of specialist supermarkets selling products from abroad. Last but not least, the city's cultural institutions offer an extraordinary range of events to suit all tastes and age groups.

This brochure, a compilation of the most important information for new international arrivals in the city, has been designed to assist new residents in settling into their new lives in the international city of Bonn or the Rhine-Sieg district.
